On Tuesday night September 11th, a not-so-ordinary gathering at TCHS feted Mary Alice and Thomas O'Malley. The Mary Alice and Thomas O'Malley Scholarship for the children of police officers, firefighters and nurses is the first of its kind in the Diocese.
