THURSDAY, MAY 24th

Prom

This year's prom, "Paris Premier," will be held at Waters Edge at Giovanni's from 7:00 p.m. until 11:00 p.m. The prom is a school event and all rules regarding student conduct will be strictly enforced.

- tickets must be purchased in advance and parents must complete a Permission Slip in order for students to attend. If a TCHS student is bringing a non-TCHS student to the prom, the TCHS parent must sign a permission slip for that student.
- if a student is absent on May 24th he/she may not attend the prom
- all students will be breathalyzed
- tickets are \$75 per student and includes hors d'ouvres, a sit down dinner with choice of two entrees and an ice cream station
- DJ music will be provided by James Daniel Entertainment and there will be a photo booth
- Ms. T will be sending out e-vites for the prom with a reply date of Thursday, May 17th
- Ms. T will also be sending a package to all juniors and seniors with permission slips and expectations for prom

- graduates are to be dressed up for graduation. Girls must wear a dress with appropriate flat shoes. Boys must wear a dress shirt and tie, with dress pants and appropriate shoes and socks. Any student not in proper attire will not be allowed to participate in the Graduation ceremony.
- graduates are to report to their homeroom no later than 9:15 a.m.
- following the ceremony, seniors will return to their homerooms to receive their actual diploma
- the Home/School Association will hold a reception immediately following the ceremony
